



## Miniature Appliqué

1-day workshop

### Workshop Supply List

Are you afraid of tiny appliqué pieces? You don't need to be! In this workshop you will learn how to deal with tiny shapes so any appliqué project is a SNAP. Leave all your preconceived notions at home, and come ready to experience an awakening of your inner talents! Some hand appliqué experience is required.

This is a process class, not a product class. You will spend your time learning, practicing and playing in miniature!



- Picture of your favorite appliqué block:** Reduced in size to 5" (preferred) or 6" (maximum). You won't begin work on this block, rather it gives you a focus during class to explore the various shapes and techniques that will help you later.
- Background Fabric:** 10"x10" (or larger) light-color or white, relatively plain without an obvious print.
- Appliqué fabrics:** Small variety of scraps, solid or nearly-solid, in medium to dark values. Just a handful will be plenty.
- REQUIRED: Milliners/Straw Needle\* size 10 or 11** (any brand). I believe my needleturn techniques work so well because of this long, thin needle. Do not bring "Hand Applique" or "Sharps", they are too short.
- Thread for appliqué:** that matches your appliqué fabric scraps. I prefer cotton Aurifil (50 weight); OK to bring what you like.
- Thread snippers, fabric scissors, and paper scissors**
- Straight pins\*:** 5-10 (short appliqué pins if you have them).
- Pen or pencil & note paper:** for taking notes.
- Optional items:** reading glasses, thimble, needle threader\*, portable light\*.
